

Parent Code of Conduct:

At no time during the course of an event will I confront a coach for any reason.

At no time during the course of an event will I criticize or confront the coaches, umpires, or any tournament official.

At no time during the course of an event will I argue or be involved in an abusive verbal or physical confrontation with another coach, parent, official or participant.

At no time during the course of an event will I use profanity/lewd gestures or misuse/damage any equipment/facility.

To respect all officials and their authority during games and never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field or the ballpark itself. Please direct any questions or comments to the Rec Office.

To be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or event.

To not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes, coaches, officials, ballpark employees and/or any park spectators.

To demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect.

To leaving each other, each dugout, each ball park, each tournament site, each facility and each situation in better shape than we found it.

To learn the rules of the game and the league and teach my child to play by these rules.

To refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices unless I am one of the official coaches of the team or have been asked to assist by an official coach of the team.
